All Bobby Calves/Kid Goats:

I will ensure that all animals are either:

- Not within any withholding period of any animal remedy or treatment administered to the calf/goat or given to the dam before the birth of the bobby calf/kid goat or given to any dam that has supplied milk to that bobby calf/kid goat, or
- If the bobby calf/kid goat is within withholding period for any animal treatment or remedy they will be clearly identified by a spray dot on the head of the affected bobby calf/kid goat.

I will ensure that no bobby calves/kid goats have been fed any ruminant protein as defined by the Biosecurity (Ruminant Protein) Regulations 1999. (see note 1)

I undertake to ensure that all who work with these animals are instructed on the need to comply with these requirements.

If I become aware of any bobby calf /kid goat that has been inadvertently presented for slaughter that is not suitable for slaughter for petfood or not meeting any of these conditions, I shall immediately inform Waikato Petfoods Ltd.

Bobby Calves/Kid Goats to be Slaughtered On-farm:

I will ensure that a secure area is available to enable the safe and hygienic slaughter and bleeding of on-farm slaughtered bobby calves/kid goats.

I will ensure all bobby calves/kid goats have been fed in the 24 hours prior to on-farm slaughter.

Bobby Calves/Kid Goats to be Collected:

I will ensure that all animal welfare requirements are met. All bobby calves/kid goats must:

- be at least four days old and not more than two months of age,
- be fit for transport, able to stand on all four legs, able to rise from a lying position and be freely able to move around,
- have no visible sign of disease, including scouring, any deformity, injury, blindness or other disability,
- the eyes shall be bright not dull or shrunken,
- have firm flat hooves, not rounded with unworn or soft tissue,
- have a dry, withered navel, not pink/red, raw or fleshy,
- be fed on the morning of uplift. The stomach must not be concave (sunken).

I acknowledge that if calves/goats do not meet these requirements, they will not be collected.

Declaration:

I declare that, as a supplier of bobby calves/kid goats for petfood, this Bobby Calf /Kid Goat Periodic Declaration is true and accurate and that I have read, understood and agree that I must abide by the requirements set out on this form. Unless I advise Waikato Petfoods Ltd of any change prior, this declaration remains valid until 31st May 2027.

Note 1: The Biosecurity (Ruminant Protein) Regulations 1999 makes it an offence to feed any ruminant with ruminant protein. Any bobby calf/kid goat that has been fed ruminant protein (eg a supplement containing meat & bone meal) is not eligible for use as petfood.

Note 2: The person signing this form must be the person with specific responsibility for the calves/goats.
